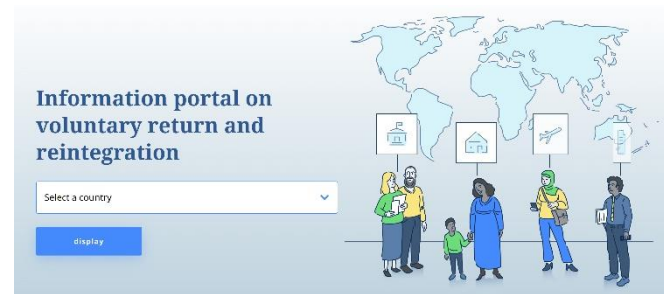

What info can you find on the website?

On the website you find info about:

1. Voluntary return of **migrants** to their home country.

Migrants are people from another country.

They have left their home country.

They now live in a foreign country.

For example in Germany.



2. Help after the return to the home country.

The difficult word for this is **re-integration.**

People get help for a new start in the home country.

For example:

- They get money for the new start.
- They get help to find a job.



For whom is the web site?

The web site is for:

2. Counseling centers for migrants.

Counseling centers are for example:

- Social welfare offices and foreigners office
- Charity organizations

What is the goal of the web site?

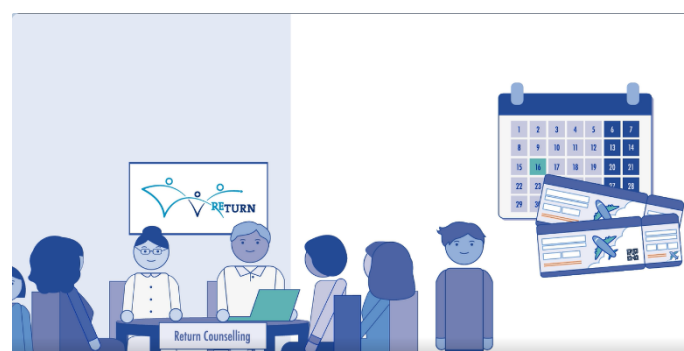
The web site gives important info to:

The counseling centers can then:

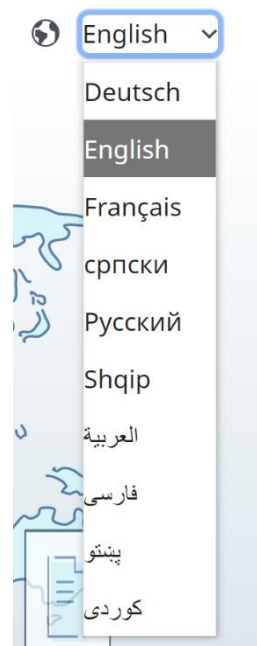
- give better info to migrants.

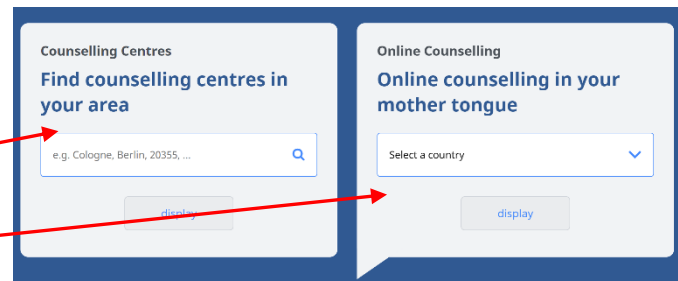

You can search the info in a **data base**.

A **data base** collects a lot of info.

The data base is called **ZIRF Data Base**.

Migrants can ask questions themselves.

IOM employees answer the questions.

Later, the answers can be found in the data base.

ZIRF-Database

As part of ZIRF Counselling, you can ask individual questions about your country of origin via a counselling centre that is authorized to make inquiries. The information is researched by the IOM on site and can help you make decisions and prepare for a possible voluntary return.

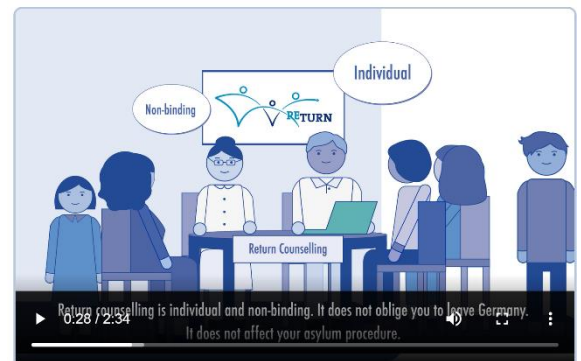


