About Joint Reintegration Services

The Joint Reintegration Services is at the core of the Frontex Reintegration Programme. It provides for the provision of reintegration assistance to returnees departing on a voluntary or non-voluntary basis from Member States and Schengen Associated Countries to their countries of origin. At the same time, it contributes to an effective return policy in the European Union, ensuring that returns are done in a dignified and humane manner. To implement this assistance, Frontex has concluded a partnership with Caritas International Belgium who cooperates with Caritas Jordan in Jordan to assure the deliverance of high level of support.



About Caritas Jordan

Caritas Jordan was established in 1967 in response to the humanitarian needs emerged from the wars and the displacement of the Palestinian people to Jordan. Since then Caritas has continued to serve conflict-affected families across the country and vulnerable Jordanians. Caritas Jordan is operating on a national level through its 12 centres spread over the country. Since 2018 Caritas Jordan is implementing reintegration support Jordanians returning Europe. They have a broad network with different organisations focussing specific vulnerabilities.
